The 2022 Annual Budget presented by the Finance Committee was approved (available <a href="here">here</a>), as well as the replacement of Paul Thompson, who has moved from the area, with Frank Dickinson as one of our registered agents.

The congregation also gave approval to application for a five-year signature loan of \$75,000 from Church Extension Board to fund our parking lot paving and gas line repairs.

We are so appreciative of the willingness of our church family to step up and become involved in so many ways in and around our campus, and in our presence as the body of Christ to our community.
